

## **2016-2017 St. Paul Sports Information**

### **Fees:**

Sports Fee: \$75 annual fee per child participating in non-intramural sports. Non-Refundable, Will be deposited within 2 weeks of receipt. Only paid once per year regardless of the number of sports played.

Concession Fee: \$100 for all volleyball and basketball players grades 3-8. Funds returned after the concession stand is worked.

Uniform Fee: \$60 deposit required for all uniforms that will be furnished by St. Paul (volleyball, basketball, softball). If the uniform is returned timely and in good condition the deposit will be returned.

### **Sports Offered:**

Volleyball – Girls in grades 3-8. Season begins late July/Early August and ends mid-late October. All three fees above apply.

Football – Boys in grades 3-8. St. Paul students play for Notre Dame. Season begins late July/Early August and ends mid-late October. No above fees apply; however, Notre Dame may assess fees.

Cheerleading - Girls K-8 can participate at Notre Dame. Season begins in late spring/early summer. No above fees apply; however, Notre Dame may assess fees.

Cross Country – Boys and Girls in grades K-8. Season begins late July/early August and ends mid-October. The Sports Fee applies.

Intramural Volleyball – Girls in grades K-2. Season begins late August and ends late October. Games are played on Friday nights at St. Rita. Above fees do not apply. An intramural fee of \$35 will be collected and a t-shirt (uniform) for the player to keep is included.

Basketball – Boys and Girls in grades 3-8. Season begins late October and ends early to mid-February. All above fees apply.

Intramural Basketball – Boys and Girls grade Pre-K (4 yr old) – 2. Season lasts 5 weeks. Practices and games are on Saturday evenings in January 2017 and the first weekend of February. Above fees do not apply. An intramural fee of \$35 will be collected and a t-shirt (uniform) for the player to keep is included.

Mini-Cheerleading – Girls grades Pre-K (4 yr old) – 2. Will cheer at the intramural basketball games. Practices and games are on Saturday evenings in January 2017 and the first weekend of February. Above fees do not apply. An intramural fee of \$35 will be collected and a t-shirt (uniform), shorts, and ribbons for the participant to keep are included.

Boys Volleyball – Boys grades 3-8. St. Paul is trying to offer teams for this sport. If we do not have enough participants anyone interested may be able to join Notre Dame’s team. The season begins mid-late February and ends before Spring Break. If playing for St. Paul the sports fee would apply and a \$15 fee will be assessed for a t-shirt (uniform) for the participant to keep. If playing for Notre Dame, their fees would apply.

Soccer – Boys and Girls grades 3-8. St. Paul is trying to offer teams for this sport. If we do not have enough participants anyone interested may be able to join Notre Dame’s team. The season begins in late February and ends in early June. If playing for St. Paul the sports fee would apply and either a \$15 fee will be assessed for a t-shirt (uniform) for the participant to keep **OR** the \$60 Uniform Fee would apply. (A determination will be made at a later date). If playing for Notre Dame, their fees would apply.

Softball – Girls grades 3-8. St. Paul is trying to offer teams for this sport. If we do not have enough participants anyone interested may be able to join Notre Dame’s team. The season begins in late February and ends in late May. If playing for St. Paul, the Sports Fee and Uniform Fee would apply. If playing for Notre Dame, their fees would apply.

Track and Field – Boys and Girls grades 5-8. The season begins late February and ends in late April. The Sports Fee would apply.

Baseball – Boys grades 3-8. The season runs from mid-April through the end of June. St. Paul is trying to offer teams for this sport. If we do not have enough participants anyone interested may be able to join Notre Dame’s team. The season runs from mid-April through the end of June. If playing for St. Paul, the Sports Fee and Uniform Fee would apply. If playing for Notre Dame, their fees would apply.

### **Combining Schools to Form Teams:**

St. Paul partners with Notre Dame Academy. We always hope to have enough participants for every sport on our own, but if we don’t, we will contact Notre Dame to see if we can combine athletes to create a team. In rare cases our athletes may participate with a different school. The Sports Committee will handle the coordination and notify the signed up athletes of which school they can join for a particular sport. Recruiting is not allowed and an athlete may not participate with a different school without approval from the Sports Committee. If an athlete signs up to play for St. Paul and there are not enough participants to form our own team the athlete is NOT required to play for another school. They can choose to not participate at all. However, only athletes who sign up with St. Paul will be offered the opportunity to play for another school.
